### Division 1: FLOWERS

1. Roses – large flowered (Hybrid Tea type): 1 stem
2. Roses – cluster flowered (Floribunda/Rambler type): 1 stem
3. Iris – 5 stems
4. Cut foliage – 5 stems (all different) NO flowers
5. Pansies or Violas – 5 with stems
6. Sweet Peas–5 stems
7. Perpetual Sweet Peas – 5 stems
8. Liliium – 4 stems
9. Container – 450mm (18”) of mixed flowers & foliage, judged on interest & quality
10. Pot plant – flowering,150mm (6”) pot or less \*
11. Pot plant – foliage,225mm (9”) pot or less \*
12. Fuchsia – 225mm (12”) pot or less\*

*\*10 – 12 must have belonged to exhibitor for 3 months +. Other exhibits in Div 1 to be home grown.*

### DIVISION 2: VEGETABLES AND FRUIT

13. Lettuces (2)
14. Beans (6 Pods)
15. Carrots (3 with 75mm (3”) stalks, cut evenly and tied with string)
16. Potatoes (3 of 1 variety)
17. Courgettes (4)
18. Tomatoes (3)
19. Soft fruit (plate of 9, with stems)
20. Any other fruit/vegetables not listed above (2)
21. Mixed herbs (vase of 5 stems, 5 varieties) NO flowers
22. Collection of vegetables (1 each of 4 varieties in a seed tray or tomato box)
23. Disaster Class – any odd or misshapen vegetable, flower or fruit

*All exhibits in Div 2 must be home grown.*

### DIVISION 3: FLORAL ART

24. “Oh I do like to be beside the seaside” (Foliage allowed)– An Exhibit 600mm (24”)
25. “Splish Splosh Splash” – An Exhibit 450mm (18”)
26. Bright Summer Days – An Exhibit 300mm (12”)

*Flowers may be bought, measurements relate to maximum width.*

#### **DIVISION 4: DOMESTIC – All items to be covered in cling film.**

27. Jar of Chutney / Pickles (1) \*
28. Jar of Marmalade (1) \*
29. Plate of Sausage Rolls (6)
30. Plate of Meringues – Can be flavoured/coloured (6)
31. Millionaire Shortbread (1)
32. Plain Victoria Sandwich – Jam only - 7" tin (1)
33. Plate of Cupcakes (6) any flavour
34. Plate of Fruit or Plain Scones (6)
35. Lemon Drizzle Cake (1)
36. Flap Jacks (6 pieces)
37. A Seaside themed novelty cake-judged on decoration only (1)
38. Vegetarian Quiche (1)
39. Flavoured Loaf (1) – Any bread type
40. Bottle of Wine or any homemade brew or soft drink (1)

*\*27 & 28 to be at least 3 months old, labelled with type/date of making and filled to top (use jam pot covers).*

#### **DIVISION 5: ART AND HANDICRAFT**

41. A piece of handmade jewellery
42. A handmade sewn fabric, knitted or embroidered item\*
43. Picture – watercolour, oils, pastel, ink or pencil – no names on front\*
44. A Famous person, character or animal made from vegetables and/or fruit only - cocktail sticks and adhesive etc, may be used to secure items. Max 30cm wide
45. "Summer Time", A photograph 125mm x 180mm maximum
46. A model of a boat (no kits), not wider/longer than 600mm
47. A sculpture or carving from wood, metal or stone, not wider/longer than 600mm

#### **DIVISION 6: CHILDREN'S CLASSES (Aged 14 or under)**

48. Plate of 6 decorated biscuits (plain biscuits can be bought, please wrap in cling film)
49. Make a model 'Seaside' on a plate (Max 300mm wide)
50. Make a collage of a sea creature out of waste wrappers or packaging (A3 max)
51. Draw or paint a picture of you and your friends at the Seaside
52. Make a sun hat from paper/card/fabric and decorate (any material)

*Children can enter any number of categories in Div 6, their age will be considered by the judges. Children may also enter any classes in the main competition, however their age will not be considered in these.*

3. All exhibits must have been grown or made by the person whose name is on the Entry Form.
4. All entries in Divisions 5 and 6 must not have been previously entered to SSSS Competition
